

Marion Baird Neville Memorial Veterinary Scholarship

The Marion Baird Neville Veterinary Scholarship is made possible through the donations of Karolynne McAteer and other individual donors and will be awarded to an ISCA member who has demonstrated an interest in and a commitment to veterinary medicine.

Scholarship Criteria

- The scholarship will be awarded to a first, second or third year veterinary student
- The applicant must be a member of ISCA in good standing for a minimum of 2 years immediately prior to application

Scholarship Payment

Chosen applicant will be awarded a one-time \$2,500 scholarship. The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution. Chosen applicant must sign an agreement stating the scholarship will be used only for tuition, fees, books and supplies. Scholarship funds will be used pro-rata over one academic school year. If the student's enrollment drops below full-time for any reason the unused balance of the scholarship will be returned to the ISCA Foundation.

Selection Committee

The Board of Directors of the Irish Setter Club of America Foundation has established a committee of four Irish Setter Club of America members who are not members of the Boards of Directors of the Irish Setter Club of America nor the Irish Setter Club of America Foundation. The committee will receive the applications and select one candidate annually based on their written qualifications. Applications will be published in the December issue of Memo to members. Completed scholarship applications must be received by the Selection Committee Coordinator by **March 29, 2024**.

- Brief letter (less than two pages) as to why you are applying and why you should be granted this scholarship
- Attach copy of your college transcript (first year veterinary scholarship applicant) or current veterinary transcript for a second or third year veterinary scholarship applicant
